**Annotation:** The conference is an opportunity for doctoral students to present their own research. It is also an opportunity to establish relationships between individual doctoral students from Charles University's Historical Sociology department and other departments in the Czech Republic and abroad. Following the conference, a board review will select articles which will be published in a collective monograph.

The goal of the conference is the development of historical sociology as a scientific discipline. The main questions of the conference will be how social processes affect individuals and groups, how collective and individual actors cope with specific social processes and historical breaks, and how they react to events. New themes, sources, methods, problems and research areas of historical sociology will be introduced.

The conference is open to active participants and listeners. Students wishing to present their research are asked to briefly describe the topic of their lecture in their confirmation. For active participants of the conference it is possible to request the reservation of a hotel room.
